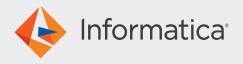

Informatica Success Story: Vemo Education

Student debt is a growing problem in the United States, more than doubling between 2007 and 2017. Today, many Americans owe more in student loans than they do on their credit cards: a whopping \$1.5 trillion, according to the Brookings Institute.

Vemo Education is helping colleges and universities offer an alternative to traditional student loans called an income share agreement (ISA), in which the student agrees to pay a small percentage of future income for a fixed period of time. Students only make payments if they earn above a minimum income threshold, and if their wages are low, so are their payments. There's no principal balance, no interest, and a clear end to the financial obligation, helping students keep their lives and career goals on track.

With ISAs becoming more popular, Vemo Education has emerged as the market leader. The company is growing quickly by helping schools launch and sustain high-impact programs that provide accessibility and affordability to students. No longer a startup, Vemo needed to optimize its processes in order to scale the business. It realized an investment in cloud integration capabilities could help connect disparate systems and processes, while still allowing Vemo to provide world-class service to schools and participants.

"We've had to invent a lot of our core processes because our business model is very unique," says Mark Ellis, Salesforce Lead at Vemo Education. "As we grow, we need to automate those processes, so we wanted a tool that would enable us to move data and apply transformations very quickly."

Automating processes with cloud integration

Since the company was founded, Vemo Education built many of its workflows and business processes on Salesforce. It has also taken full advantage of the cloud, running its Microsoft SQL Server databases on Amazon Web Services (AWS). To automate processes without changing its cloud infrastructure, Vemo Education selected Informatica Intelligent Cloud Services (IICS) to securely move data from Salesforce into AWS for staging and processing via integration platform as a service (iPaaS). Once processing is complete, data is either pushed back into Salesforce or moved to a Snowflake data warehouse using IICS.

"Using Informatica Intelligent Cloud Services to interact and move data into Snowflake is straightforward and a relatively quick integration to turnaround," says Ellis. "Using IICS is nice because we're able to process data and do joins ahead of time, before it gets into Snowflake, which is a very good value proposition for us."

Vemo Education is also using the Informatica Cloud REST API connector to securely integrate external APIs. "It efficiently and securely allows us to retrieve public tokens, exchange them for secure private tokens, listen for messages, and retrieve data," says Ellis. The information is then integrated with Salesforce on a nightly basis using Informatica Cloud Data Integration, another IICS service.

Scalable Processes to Drive Business Impact

"Using Informatica Intelligent Cloud Services to query our Salesforce data, incorporate APIs, and increase automation represents an enormous improvement in our process," says Ellis. "We're getting approximately 200 hours of employee time back every month that we can reallocate to higher-value tasks, like strengthening our partner relationships."

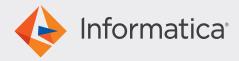
Integrating with APIs helps improve the availability of real-time data that can help the business make timely decisions.

"With Informatica Intelligent Cloud Services, we've been able to enhance the flow of data throughout our business," says Ellis. "We're able to minimize disparities in information and use real-time data to respond more quickly."

Modernizing data warehousing

Using Informatica Intelligent Cloud Services to bring income share data from Salesforce into SQL Server and Snowflake is helping Vemo Education improve the speed of the information services it delivers to the business and its customers.

"We selected Snowflake because it gives us the ability to have multiple secure data warehouses and optimize performance for each," says Ellis. "We can't do that on SQL Server because it exists on a single Amazon Elastic Compute Cloud (EC2) instance that has a fixed amount of compute power. Informatica Intelligent Cloud Services makes it very easy to get data into Snowflake, which gives us a lot of flexibility."

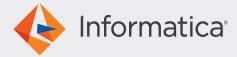
